


"Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me.

Mark 9:37

TO KNOW: This passage marks a turning point in Mark's gospel. Jesus had left Galilee where he was safe and took the first step toward Jerusalem and the Cross that awaited him there. For the second time, Jesus taught his followers about his coming passion and death, but they did not understand his words. When they arrived in Capernaum, Jesus asked his disciples what they had been arguing about on the way. They were embarrassed because they had been discussing what rank each would have in the kingdom. Jesus placed a small child in their midst and taught them an important lesson. Those who wished to be his disciples should not be concerned about ambition and prestige. God's kingdom would be attained through service to the poor and lowly. Anyone who served these little ones of simple faith were in reality serving Jesus and the Father who sent him.

TO LOVE: Do I strive to serve others or am I self-serving?

TO SERVE: Lord Jesus, help me to recognize you in the weak and powerless people I meet.

Nehemiah 2:20 I would like to make an update on our roof restoration project and the outcome of our site meeting attended by Roof and Renders, FAS Adelaide, Scaffolding company, and the Archdiocesan Property office.

I am glad to inform you that the roof restoration and the aircondition work is going to begin on the 30th September 2024. Due to start of the work, we have to make some changes on the use of the church for our worship and celebration of other Sacraments. My sincere apologies for any inconveniences due to the ongoing maintenance of our church. Please note the following changes:

- Weekday Masses and funerals will be celebrated at the hall
- Weekend Masses and Mind Masses will be celebrated at the church
- Adoration will <u>be suspended</u> during this time.
- Driveway at the back of the hall and church will be closed from the 30th September till the completion of the project.
- Parish office will operate as normal.


