FRIARY AND THE LAND UPDATE

BACKGROUND

- The Friary and the land attached to it were belong to the Capuchin Friars.
- In 2013, the Capuchins sold the property to the Archdiocese.
- Capuchins left the Parish in February 2024.
- From February, the Parish Priest resides at the friary.
- The Parish is responsible for the accommodation of priests in the parish.

After having a few meetings with the Archdiocesan Property Office and the Archdiocese Finance Administrator, we are proposing a future plan for the Friary and the site for the better future of the parish and the school. This is the concept plan that will be proposed to our Archbishop for his consideration and approval.

The proposal we put forward is:

Recommendation

- 1. Land Transfer: It is proposed that the Archdiocese transfer ownership of the Friary land to the Parish at no cost, thereby enabling the Parish to repurpose the property for the development of an Early Learning Centre that will benefit the community and significantly enhance the educational offering of the Parish school.
- 2. Building: The third party (ELC) is responsible to build the Early Learning Centre. It is leased for a stipulated period of time (accepted by the Archdiocese and the third party).
- 3. **Rental Income**: The Parish to benefit from a ground lease from the development of an ELC. This arrangement will demonstrate the Archdiocese's support for the parish.
- 4. Temporary Rental: The Parish to cover the rent for a priest accommodation till alternative provisions are made.
- 5. New Presbytery: The Parish will need to rent a new presbytery in the interim and perhaps work toward purchasing or building a new presbytery and parish office.

Merits of the Proposal

- Financial Relief and Sustainability: The rental income from the ELC will provide the Parish with a reliable source of funds, alleviating financial pressures and supporting future Parish development initiatives
- Community Support: This proposal strengthens the bond between the Archdiocese and the Parish, showcasing a commitment to the Parish's long-term viability and growth.
- Strategic Asset Use: Transferring the land of the Friary for the Parish's use and control allows for better utilisation of the land.

FUTURE PLAN PROPOSAL (Fr. Anthoni Adimai SdM)

- Occupy 5 metres from the friary land attached to the land in front of the friary.
- As we receive the lease amount, the parish can take a loan to build a presbytery and a parish office.

Master, I want to see. Mark 10:51

125 The Lord has done great things for us;

TO KNOW: As Jesus and his disciples journeyed to Jerusalem, they passed through Jericho, the city of Israel's triumphant victory over their enemies through God's intervention (Joshua 6:20). Jesus had been teaching his disciples about the necessity of renunciation and of his sacrificial death (Mk 9:43-10:45). But they still did not understand the meaning of Jesus' words and were blind to his message and mission. As they entered Jericho, a blind beggar, Bartimaeus, son of Timaeus, cried out to Jesus for pity, according to him the Messianic title "Son of David." Although some people ordered him to be quiet, Bartimaeus called out all the more. His faith was rewarded when Jesus beckoned him to come. Casting aside his cloak, his sole position, Bartimaeus rushed to Jesus for healing, and he was cured immediately. Indeed, the blind man had greater faith than Jesus' disciples, and he followed him on "the way" (v 52, an early name for the Christian faith).

TO LOVE: What prevents me from seeing Jesus today?

TO SERVE: Lord Jesus, open my eyes to your presence in my life.


