

# ST FRANCIS OF ASSISI CATHOLIC PARISH

# FEAST OF SAINT FRANCIS OF ASSISI SUNDAY, 6 OCTOBER 2024



Preach the Gospel at all times and, when necessary, use words.

Francis, the son of a rich cloth merchant, led a misspent youth.

His search for conversion led him to the ancient church at San Damiano. While he was praying there, he heard Christ speak to him from the crucifix, "Francis, repair my church." Not being a man of half measures, he took the Lord at his word and began to repair the old ruined chapel of San Damiano. Only later did he come to realise that the Lord was asking him to renew his people — the Church.

He began to proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ and live his Way of Life. Before long, this itinerant beggar preacher became widely known for his holiness and radical self-giving to the Lord. Prayer, poverty, affectionate love for creation and loyalty to the Church's mission became hallmarks of Francis. Within his own lifetime, many gave up their possessions and decided to be just as he was — penitent preachers of the Gospel. In 1209 they gave birth to the Franciscan brotherhood: the Order of Friars Minor.

The Spirit of St Francis has been kept alive through the centuries by the Friars Minor (1st Order), the followers of St Clare (2nd Order) and the Secular Franciscans (3rd Order). Franciscans have a particular call to serve the poor, the marginalised, those living on the fringes of society and the church. They are called to be reconcilers as heralds and craftsmen of peace. Let us follow Jesus with the example of Saint Francis of Assisi!

#### 27TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - YEAR B Francis, the man of God, left his home **ENTRANCE** behind, abandoned his inheritance and **ANTIPHON** became poor and penniless, but the Lord raised him up. Sirach 50:1-6 1st READING: Francis, resplendent like the sun, shines forth in the temple of God. RESPONSORIAL Psalm 16 **PSALM:** You, Lord, are my allotted portion Galatians 6:14-18 2<sup>nd</sup> READING: The marks on my body are those of Jesus. Alleluia, alleluia! Francis poor and humble, enters heaven GOSPEL **ACCLAMATION** rich, he is honoured by heavenly hymns. Alleluia! Matthew 11:25-30 **GOSPEL:** You have hidden from the learned what you have revealed to the merest children. Blessed are the poor in spirit, COMMUNION **ANTIPHON** for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven.
